### To companies and organizations interested in developing leaders:

The Main Line Chamber of Commerce is reserving spots in the 2020 class of Leadership Main Line, which provides leadership development through a lens of community involvement. Leadership Main Line develops personal **leadership** skills, with a particular focus on nonprofit board service. Participants learn to create a rewarding **legacy** for themselves and their companies as they strengthen their **connection** with a powerful network of leaders. As many as 25 participants go through this professionally facilitated program. They are inspired by regional business leaders, including outstanding nonprofit CEOs. They learn about the community, are exposed to leadership styles and concepts, and collaborate on an impactful project for a local nonprofit.

Leadership Main Line has limited availability. Each company will be limited to four slots per cohort. Speakers are passionate and inspiring regional leaders.

### Time commitment

Day sessions are set for 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Jan. 28, Feb. 25, March 24, April 28, May 19 and June 16 (2020). Evening sessions, which are devoted to completing a project for a nonprofit organization, are held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Jan. 16 (Orientation), Feb. 13, March 12, April 16, May 14 and June 4 (2020). Graduation will be held at lunchtime on June 25 at the Celebration of Business Leadership.

### 2020 rates

Rates are \$3,000 for a standard-level Main Line Chamber of Commerce member. Gold Level members receive a \$300 discount per person.

### The application process

Two references will be required and an interview with volunteer Leadership Main Line Steering Committee members and the program facilitator will be scheduled for each applicant.

**Deadline:** Applications are now being accepted. Recruiting will end when the program reaches capacity at 25.

### Who participates?

Companies typically nominate executives at vice president, director and manager levels who vary from being high-potential individuals on a path toward promotion to experienced contributors. Diversity of participants enriches the entire experience.
